Prompts:

- *Prepare for the following four prompts. On the day of the timed-write, one of the four will be selected at random for each class.
- 1. What is the "something ungraspable" (37) that Ralph cannot defeat?
- 2. How does Golding's use of symbolism reveal the boys' changing identities?
- 3. Ralph states: "Things are breaking up. I don't understand why. We began well. We were happy." Provide an analysis of what went wrong and, most importantly, why.
- 4. Do the boys denature the island or does the island de-civilize the boys?

Requirements:

- 1. All basic requirements and standards of the MLA paper are still to be followed.
- 2. Each body paragraph must have at least one quotation
- 3. Handwriting must be clearly legible or points will be deducted from the score.

Tips:

- 1. Keep the argument focused and direct; I am looking for clarity and coherence.
- 2. Use the first 5-10 minutes to create an outline that organizes your argument before you begin writing the final draft.
